17- Swan Island sighted after Von Spee's men spent two hours in Coors nest looking for it. Smoked Pot locker overboard - all paint aboard ships lost.

18. Changed clocks to +5 zone time.

19. 2010 ck 180°T. - 2200 Laying to off Colon harbor - 400 yds abeam of entrance buoy. Pilot aboard to make entrance. Turned on running lights a bit late - ships all would. 2337. Anchored in inner harbor Colon.

20. Moored at 0736 to Pier #1, Ceres Solo Naval Base, C.Z. Provisions, G.S.C about 1526 - LSM 88 moored alongside 5th

21. Still moored: fueling.

22. 0704. Underway to go thru canal. 0755 anchored in Heron Bay. Comptos adjester aboard: 1232 Pilot C.O.
